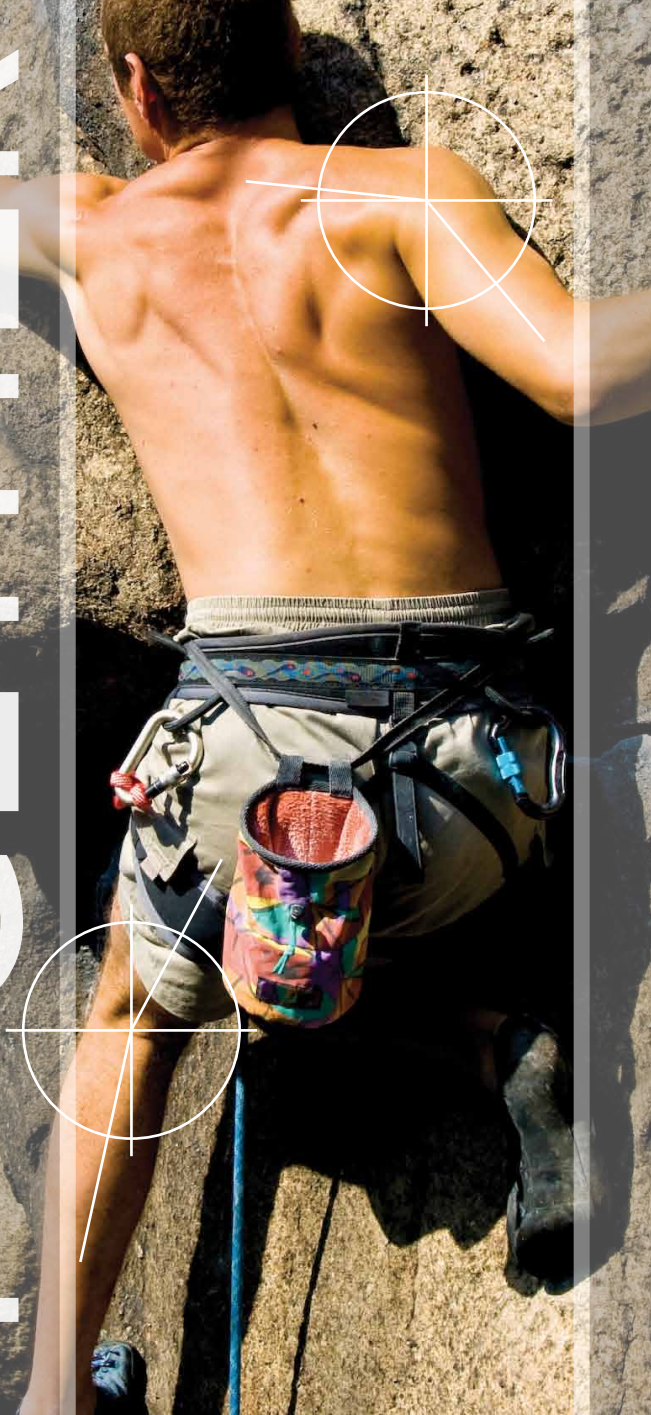

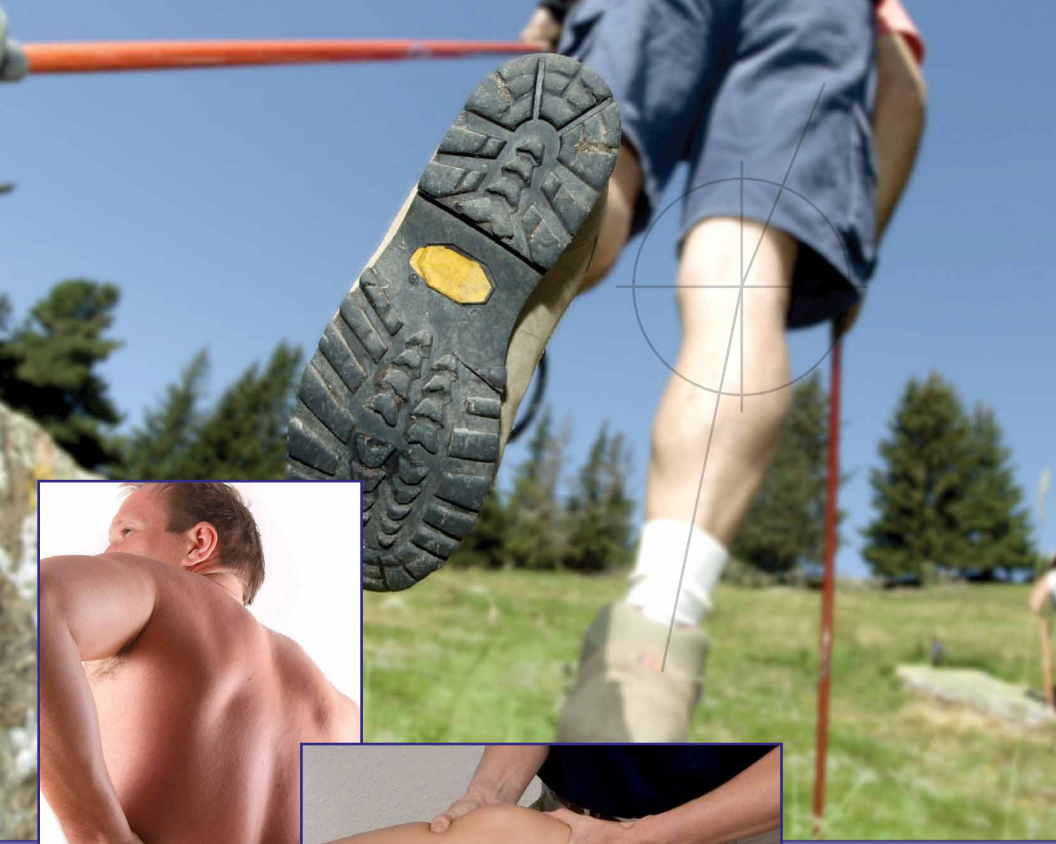
Meet Our Therapists
